When a 33-year-old man was grievously injured at work, the last thing he might have expected he would need as part of his recovery was a real estate agent. But that's exactly what the father of two required after falling from a second-story balcony on the job and becoming a paraplegic. Following the accident, our team at Apricus was tasked with finding a new house for the man, whom we'll call Bill, so that he could continue raising his son and daughter.
